Maybe you require something a little smaller? Our ebay shop 'The Chandelier Shop' has a number of components from lamp holders to light bulbs.





Guidelines on the use of incandescent light bulbs

Traditional incandescent light bulbs are very inefficient wasting 95% of the electricity they use by turning it into heat. Under new EU rules, they're being phased out and replaced by energy efficient light bulbs.

This process began in 2009 when the manufacture of 100W clear and all pearl light bulbs was stopped. In September 2011, 60W clear bulbs were also banned from being produced and more recently the production of 40W and 25W clear bulbs ceased in September 2012.

These bulbs are not being removed from sale – existing stocks are available and we'll continue to supply them until stocks run out. 7W tungsten bulbs are still readily available until further notice.

As an alternative, halogen light bulbs are a viable economic and environmental option, the increased costing from the

conventional light bulb is justified with the lifespan of the bulb being twice and long as well as

delivering a 30% saving in energy consumption. The wattage required is also reduced, with a 28W bulb emitting the same amount of light as a traditional 40W bulb.

Now is a great time to re-evaluate the lighting in your home or workplace. We have a number of bulb fittings available and LED bulbs can also be sourced upon request. We can offer re-wiring services for a multitude of lighting products from large chandeliers to table lamps.
