# Rewiring

At our workshops we have been completing a lot of rewiring jobs for public buildings, property management companies and private clients, this is due to the European ban on standard incandescent light bulbs from September 2009, making it difficult to source a large number of light bulbs.

This is why we recommend that all rewiring is completed with E14 (SES) lamp holders as this thread as light bulbs to fit this cap can be found in the biggest variety of shapes and wattages unlike MES or BC which have seen a large reduction in the styles available.

We can also rewire to meet American specifications, using E12 or E26 threads and are wired to meet UL rated safety requirements.

#### **Glass Repairs**

We have recently started using two new adhesives to help with glass repairs. The first is used to rebond two broken pieces of glass together, while the second is used as a filler to replace any small holes or cracks in while small pieces or shards of glass have been lost.
