We were recently commissioned to produce a chandelier for the pastry room of a private residence which included the use on ice cream sundae glasses and to the left you can see the finished product. At over a metre wide it certainly makes a statement in the room.

The 4 tier stainless steel frame holds 62 sundae glasses. Each glass is simply slotted into position rather than being fixed, however it has been installed high enough so that there is no risk of accidental knocks or the chance that someone may borrow one for their own ice cream sundae.
