Our Secret Project Revealed

This month an exciting project that we worked on last year is finally being revealed. After months of secrecy we can finally reveal that **The Lanesborough** will be opening its doors today (1st July) with many of its rooms featuring our chandeliers.

The exclusive Hyde Park Corner hotel has reopened after 18 months following a full restoration of the property.

In total they ordered 78 pieces from us, of which 51 were crystal chandeliers, including the bespoke chandelier seen on the right, that was designed for the Royal Suite. All rooms and Suites will be available for booking from 15th July.

This was the largest single order for chandeliers that Wilkinson Plc have ever received and were delighted to be selected by renowned designer Alberto Pinto for this project, especially as this turned out to be one of his final projects before his passing in 2012.
