Cracks in glass

Although we are able to remove chips from glass quite successfully, there is no machine that we are able to use to remove cracks from glass. However there is a method in which we can drill a small pin hole at the end of a crack to prevent it from running any further (see faint red circles in image to right). This option is often used on sentimental pieces so that the item can still be displayed or in some cases used without the risk that it may crack further and break into pieces. – <u>repairs@wilkinson-plc.com</u>
