An item that we forgot to show you in last month's newsletter, that featured a number of the stock items that we have for sale, is this beautiful antique 8 light Regency tent and waterfall chandelier circa 1820-30. It has 8 metal arms with cut glass drip pans and illustrated with tall French candles and also contains 8 internal lamps. A cut glass vase and dish support a row of rule drops and a tent of graduated round double point buttons, and below it, a five tier waterfall.

Standing at 105cm tall and 81cm wide it would certainly make a statement in any room.
